First of all, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to meet you at the Munich Security Conference 2019 and a chance to discuss with you about important issues such as conflict of interests, among others. However, Czech media brought an information last days that next meeting of the Committee on Budgetary Control of the European Parliament, scheduled on April 15, 2019 at 19:00, will be in regime 'in camera' or at least the part about the audit of the European Commission which took place in the Czech Republic in January 2019.

Due to the importance of the issue related to the transparent process of drawing EU funds in the Czech Republic which is heavily connected with the conflict of interests of some members of current Czech government we would like to call on the European Commission to provide as soon as possible appropriate documents with EC's findings also to all members of the Chamber of Deputies, as representative of the main legislative house of Czech Parliament, which also has an important function in the control of the work of the government.
