Please find below our clarifications.

1. *Did the European Commission instruct the Czech Paying Agency to start allocating and disbursing agricultural subsidies to Agrofert?*

No. The European Commission did not instruct the Czech Paying Agency to start allocating or disbursing agricultural subsidies to Agrofert. The European Commission noted that for agricultural subsidies, Articles 11 and 22 of Regulation (EU) 2022/128 require Member States to declare all payments effected during the relevant reference period to the Commission. However, the Commission also recalled that under the applicable national rules, the Member State may suspend or delay their own selection and payment procedures where necessary to protect Union financial interests, thereby avoiding a situation in which expenditure would need to be declared to the Commission while relevant controls, checks or audits are ongoing.

2. *Is the title of the article accurate?*

The title of the article is not correct (it is misleading).

3. *Is it still the case that the Commission is assessing the conflict of interest situation under Article 61 of the Financial Regulation?*

Yes. The Commission is currently assessing the relevant facts concerning the trust fund arrangements and the potential application of Article 61 of the Financial Regulation, as well as measures to be taken.
